Mancelona Elementary and Middle School Parent Involvement Policy

The Elementary and Middle School believe that the education of children is a joint responsibility, one it shares with the parents of the school community. To ensure that the best interests of the child are served in this process, a strong program of communication between home and school must be maintained.

Parental involvement means the participation of parents in regular, two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring—

- (A) An annual opportunity to meet and discuss requirements and parental rights/responsibilities, including the Parent Compact;
- (B) Parents are involved in the planning and review of programs;
- (C) A review of curricular materials and assessments;
- (D) Reasonable access to school staff and regular reporting of student progress;
- (E) Assisting parents with information, educational opportunities, access to support agencies;
- (F) Volunteer opportunities are available;

The above points tie directly to district bylaws & policies, Title I & NCLB language.
