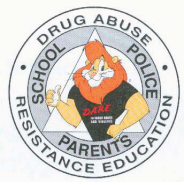


Deputy Bob's Corner



There are three areas that often cause concern, for both parents and schools. If left unchecked they may require my involvement. I would like to define these areas, so that you will be able to work with your child before problems occur.

- 1) Truancy: failure to attend school or absent from school without permission.
- 2) Incurrable: An incurrable youth is a person under the age of seventeen whom...*"Is repeatedly disobedient to the reasonable and lawful commands of his or her parents, guardian, or custodian and the court finds on the record by clear and convincing evidence that court-accessed services are necessary"*.
- 3) Delinquent: Parents, it is your responsibility to make sure your student attends school and follows the rules.

Children of all ages may experience some difficulty with one of the above areas. It is part of my role, as a school liaison officer, to file reports with the prosecutor's office if a problem persists. Please contact me if you have any questions or concerns about these, or any other area.
