We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for the Mancelona Middle School. For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not given a label.

Mancelona Middle School recognizes the gaps created due to the pandemic of these past years, and the impact this has had on our students. Reading initiatives will continue to be a significant focus for us in our building as we have dedicated staff and time to this endeavor. Reading interventions are occurring based on NWEA scores as well as a reflection of some of the data provided. Math skills have been identified as well, and we have devoted time to meet needs in math as well. Our district recognizes the importance of a sound curriculum and the use of data to inform our instruction. We continue to focus on the use of formative assessment to ensure that we have both identified and aligned necessary skills as well as informing staff on best practices in the endeavor of being data informed.

PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Mancelona Public Schools offers one middle school. Students grades 5-8 are assigned to it upon enrollment.

STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Mancelona Middle School is in the middle of a 3-5 year school improvement cycle. The focus has been on formative assessment as it applies to our curriculum as well as our instructional decision making. Our teaching staff has been trained extensively in practice, and is now in the stages of fidelity checks which is done mostly through peer observation and administrative review. We also have recognized the need for social and emotional support for our students, and have acquired social workers at the elementary as well as middle school buildings.
